- Note 1 The value of our residence was determined by looking at three sources (Zillow, Redfin, Realtor.com, Ziprealty, etc.) and dividing that total amount by three (\$675,425 + 688,268 + 702,362 = 2,066,055 / 3 = \$688,685).
- Note 2 The current mortgage balance on our residence located at 2909 ABC Lane is \$255,785 and the monthly payment amount is \$2,190.43.
- Note 3 The value of our rental property located at 2776 XYZ Street was determined by looking at three sources (Zillow, Redfin, Realtor.com, Ziprealty, etc.) and dividing that total amount by three (\$530,642 + 535,888 + 540,234 = 1,606,764 / 3 = \$535,588).
- Note 4 The monthly rent for 2776 XYZ Street is \$2,050 per month.
- Note 5 The current mortgage balance on our rental property located at 2776 XYZ Street is \$145,740 and the monthly payment amount is \$1,288.55.
- Note 6 The value of our loft in San Francisco was determined by looking at three sources (Zillow, Redfin, Realtor.com, Ziprealty, etc.) and dividing that total amount by three (\$890,482 + 860,478 + 878,624 = 2,629,584 / 3 = \$876,528).
- Note 7 The values of our automobiles, trucks, SUVs, RVs, Boats, Airplanes, ATVs were determined using Kelley Blue Book (KBB), NADA Guide, and / or Edmunds. The private party value (ppv) of our 2015 Honda Accord LX with 52,000 miles is \$13,918. There is no loan balance. The ppv of our 2018 BMW 330I with 11,050 miles is \$30,414. The loan balance owed is \$25,250, with a monthly payment of \$588.44.
- Note 8 We own a 2017 R Pod 179 travel trailer. The Nada Guide average retail value is \$11,850, the balance owed on the trailer is \$8,988, and our monthly payment is \$244.16.
- Note 9 This is the estimated value of an LLC or sole proprietorship owned 100% by Mr. and Ms. John and Jane Doe. The estimated value is based on the book value of the assets held by the LLC or Sole Proprietorship. This is also based on the income produced by the business. The estimated value is \$165,000.
- Note 10 We (Mr. and Ms. John and Jane Doe) filed our 2018 income taxes on a timely basis. We currently owe \$21,000 for our 2018 federal income taxes and \$5,500 for our state income taxes, for a total amount due of \$26,500.
