## Draft Off-Site Work Plan Available

DTSC would like to announce that the Draft Off-Site Work plan (OSP) is available for viewing in Envirostor at the following link:

DTSC developed the OSP in response to community requests to further evaluate areas outside of the former PureGro facility. Sampling conducted during the 2006 off-site removal action indicated that no contaminants above residential screening levels were detected in the soils to the south of the Site. Some contaminants extended to the east, however, those soils were removed and replaced with clean soil.

The OSP sampling strategy is based on an air modeling conducted by the California Air Resources Board that predicts the direction and distance that dust could settle. For purposes of this investigation DTSC is assuming that contaminants from the site could possibly be carried off-site in the dust. This OSP is designed to collect samples in and beyond the highest predicted dust settlement areas indicated by the model. DTSC will provide additional notification when the plan is finalized and ready for implementation.
