EMERGENCY PERMIT

NAVAL AIR FACILITY, EL CENTRO

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to the Naval Air Facility (NAF), El Centro, for the treatment of hazardous waste. The treatment of hazardous waste involves the open detonation of one MK-58 MOD 1 Marine Marker. U.S. Navy Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Mobile Unit 3 personnel will conduct this treatment. The item is in a safe holding area at Naval Base Coronado and will be transported to the established EOD site on the NAF El Centro Bombing range.

The item has been determined to require treatment by detonation. No hazardous waste is expected to be generated from the disposal by detonation. However, if required, any hazardous waste generated must be moved to an authorized unit for storage and shipped in accordance with the applicable regulatory and statutory requirements. DTSC has determined that this item poses an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment and therefore an emergency permit has been issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from October 3, 2022, through December 31, 2022. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
