SCP Program's Mission and Goals

- Reduce hazardous chemicals in consumer products
- Increase adoption of green chemistry principles and safer alternatives to chemicals of concern in consumer products




Safer Consumer Products (SCP)

Reducing toxic chemicals in products that consumers buy and use






SCP Framework Process- Candidate Chemical List





SCP Framework Process- Priority Products




Priority Product: productchemical combination defined by DTSC regulations and meets the following criteria

- potential public and/or aquatic, avian, or terrestrial organism exposure to the Candidate Chemical(s) in the product
- potential for one or more exposures to contribute to or cause significant or widespread adverse impacts




SCP Framework Process- Alternatives Analysis
