



## The primary duty to comply falls on Priority Product manufacturers

### Regulations effective Priority Product Notifications (PPNs) due



Submit on calsafer.dtsc.ca.gov




- Include:
  - Contact information
  - List of all Priority Products manufactured by your company available for sale in California
- Submit only one PPN for all your products.



## The PPN submission starts the manufacturers' compliance workflow

Regulations effective
Priority Product Notifications (PPNs) due
Preliminary Alternatives Analysis Report due





#### Who is a manufacturer?

- "Manufacturer" = any person who:
  - manufactures a Priority Product available for purchase in California (including online)...
  - controls the Priority Product's manufacturing process...
  - specifies the chemicals to be included in the Priority Product
- Regardless of where manufacturers are located (inside or outside U.S.), they must comply if their products are for sale in California.



#### A tale of two rugs (available for purchase in California)



Rug that contains PFASs: Manufacturer must submit a PPN



Rug that does NOT contain PFASs:
Manufacturer does not need to submit a PPN


Exception: When DTSC issues an Alternatives Analysis Threshold (AAT), all manufacturers need to demonstrate that the concentration of the Chemical of Concern in their product is below the threshold set by DTSC (see AAT training module).



#### Who is a manufacturer?

 Multiple entities along the supply chain may be considered manufacturers for the purpose of compliance.

- PFAS-free formulation
- **Known PFASs**
- Proprietary formulation
  If unknown PFASs in formula,
  its manufacturer must comply
  under the SCP regulations





#### How about importers, assemblers, and retailers?

Product is manufactured.

If manufacturer fails to comply,
 DTSC places manufacturer on Failure to Comply list

### Product is imported.



DTSC notifies importers that they have a duty to comply by submitting a PPN or Cease Ordering Notification

- "Importer" means a person who brings, or arranges to bring, a Priority Product into the United States for the purpose of placing the product into the stream of commerce in California.
- "Importer" does not include a person who imports a product solely for use in that person's workplace if that product is not sold or distributed to others.



#### How about importers, assemblers, and retailers?

Product is manufactured.

If manufacturer fails to comply,
 DTSC places manufacturer on Failure to Comply list

Product is imported.



DTSC notifies importers that they have a duty to comply by submitting PPN or Cease Ordering Notification

If importer fails to comply, DTSC places importer on Failure to Comply list, and...

...DTSC notifies assemblers (if any) and retailers that they have a duty to comply by submitting a PPN or Cease Ordering Notification

- "Assembler" means any person who fits, joins, puts, or otherwise brings together components to create, repair, refurbish, maintain, or make non-material alterations to a Priority Product.
- "Retailer" means a person to whom a Priority Product is delivered or sold for purposes of sale or distribution to a consumer.




## Summary: Who's who?

Do you manufacture or control the manufacturing process for a Priority Product sold in California? YES NO You are a Do you specify the use of the Chemical of Concern in a Priority YES Product manufactured by someone else and sold in California? Priority **Product** NO manufacturer Do you manufacture trade secret chemical mixtures that contain YES the Chemical of Concern and are used in a Priority Product sold in California? NO Do you package, label, or make any other non-material You are a Priority YES Product assembler alterations to a Priority Product? NO You are a Priority YES Do you import a Priority Product into California? **Product importer** NO You are a Priority YES Do you sell a Priority Product directly to consumers in California? **Product retailer** NO



You are not a Responsible Entity.
