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Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration Checklist

Note: To avoid processing delays, send all forms, including insurance documents, in the same application package. Submitting forms separately may cause delays.

To apply for a new registration as a hazardous waste transporter, or to renew your current registration, you must submit the following documents.

1. [Hazardous Waste Transporter Registration Application \(DTSC Form 187\)](#)

Note: This form requires an original "wet signature."

2. **Proof of Insurance** – Two types of insurance forms are required.

Note: All insurance forms require an original "wet signature." (Typed, digital, or facsimile signatures may result in a deficiency.)

- Either:
[Endorsement for Motor Carrier Policies of Insurance for Public Liability \(MCS- 90\)](#)
or
[Motor Carrier Surety Bond for Public Liability \(MCS-82\)](#)

AND

- Either:
[Certificate of Insurance for Public Liability Coverage \(DTSC Form 8038\)](#)
or
Certificate of Liability Insurance (COI)
or
ACORD Form
- Note: A letter of self-Insurance is an acceptable proof of insurance for government agencies only.

3. **Active ID Number**

If you do not have an ID number, [apply for one here](#).

Note: Transporters of hazardous waste are required to have a permanent identification number.

4. **[Consolidated Transporter Notification \(DTSC Form 1299\)](#)** (if applicable)

5. **[Transportation Regulatory Exemption Application/Variance \(DTSC Form 1294\)](#)** (if applicable)

6. **[Hazardous Waste Management Program Disclosure Statement \(DTSC Form 1365\)](#)** (if applicable)

- Note: Anyone who transports [Hazardous Waste of Concern](#) (HWC) or operates a Treatment, Storage, and Disposal Facility (TSDF) that handles HWC must provide DTSC with a [Disclosure Statement](#) when applying for a new permit, permit renewal, or modification to an authorization or permit issued by DTSC.
