

# DTSC PUBLIC NOTICE

## EMERGENCY PERMIT - HEXCEL CORPORATION

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) issued an Emergency Permit to **Hexcel Corporation** for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at **11711 Dublin Boulevard, Dublin, California 94568**. The items to be treated include two containers of Tetrahydrofuran, six containers of 1,3 Dioxolane, one container of Mixture of Benzoyl Alcohol, 1,3 Dioxolane and 1,3 Dioxolane, one container of Methyl Ethyl Ketone Peroxide and one container of Waste Mixed Solvent with Hydroquinone and MEKP.

The Advanced Chemical Transport, Inc. was contracted to conduct this treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be moved offsite for proper management. DTSC determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to people and the environment if not properly managed. This Emergency Permit is effective from January 24, 2023, through April 23, 2023. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA):** DTSC determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
