## EMERGENCY PERMIT MCAS MIRAMAR BUILDING 6022 SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA 92145-2509

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar to destroy the compromised explosive devices recovered from a crashed military aircraft at a nearby location of Building 6022, San Diego, California 92145-2509. The items to be treated include: two (2) Mk 124 Mod 0 Signal, Smoke / Illumination; one (1) Mk 124 Mod 0 Impulse Cartridge; one (1) Mk 2 Mod 1 Impulse Cartridge; two (2) Impulse Cartridges; fourteen (14) Mk 80 Mod 2 Signal, Hand Fired; and eleven (11) Mk 124 Mod 0 Signal, Smoke / Illumination.

The MCAS Miramar Explosive Ordinance Disposal Team (EOD) has been tasked to conduct the treatment. The hazardous items are potentially explosive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The hazardous items are planned to be destroyed and completely consumed by explosion to leave little to no residue. DTSC has determined that these compromised devices pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from April 2, 2024 through May 31, 2024. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA):** DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
