EMERGENCY PERMIT CODEXIS, INC.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Codexis, Inc. for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 200 Penobscot Drive, Redwood City, CA 94063. The items to be treated include four (4) containers of Acetaldehyde, two (2) containers of Tetrahydrofuran, one (1) container of Diethyl Ether, two (2) containers of p-Dioxane, one (1) container of Diethylene Glycol Dimethyl Ether, one (1) container of 4-Methyl-2-Pentanone, one (1) container of 1,2 Dimethoxyethane.

The Clean Harbors Environmental Services (Clean Harbors) has been contracted to conduct this treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an emergency permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from **February 4**, **2024**, **through April 5**, **2024**. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
