EMERGENCY PERMIT TO MANAGE HAZARDOUS WASTE WORLD OIL ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES 1300 SOUTH SANTA FE AVENUE COMPTON, CALIFORNIA 90221

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to World Oil Environmental Services (Facility) for storage of a tank trailer containing approximately 1,160 gallons of polychlorinated biphenyl contaminated used oil past the storage limit of ten (10) days at 1300 South Santa Fe Avenue, Compton, California 90221 until an authorized facility can accept the hazardous waste.

On August 10, 2024, the Facility picked up used oil from 7 generators. Upon completion of testing, the used oil was found to be contaminated with >5 parts per million (ppm) of polychlorinated biphenyl (PC B) and is classified as a Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) waste. The Facility does not have a permit to manage the TSCA waste. A facility authorized to store, treat, and dispose of the TSCA waste is not able to accept the waste prior to the ten (10) day storage limit. DTSC has determined that the TSCA waste poses an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit should be issued. **This Emergency Permit is effective from August 28, 2024 through September 30, 2024.** The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
