EMERGENCY PERMIT TO MANAGE HAZARDOUS WASTE EXELIXIS INC. 1701 HARBOR BAY PARKWAY, ALAMEDA, CALIFORNIA 94502

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Exelixis Inc. (Exelixis) for on-site treatment of expired chemicals at 1701 Harbor Bay Parkway, Alameda, California, 94502. The items to be treated include thirty-nine (39) containers of Tetrahydrofuran (THF), one (1) container of 1,4 Dioxane, one (1) container of Tert-Butyl methyl ether, five (5) containers of Acrolein diethyl acetal, one (1) container of 2-butanol, and one (1) container of Phenethyl alcohol.

The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of liquid solution to the container to stabilize the chemical. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported off-site for proper management. DTSC has determined that the chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from April 29, 2024 through June 29, 2024. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
