EMERGENCY PERMIT PERKIN ELMER 5070 ROBERT J MATHEWS PKWY EL DORADO HILLS, CALIFORNIA 95762

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Perkin Elmer for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 5070 Robert J Mathews Parkway, El Dorado Hills, California, 95762. The items treated include one (1) 5-gram container of 97% 2,4-Dinitrophenol, two (2) 25-gram containers of 2,2'-Azobis (2-methylpropionitrile), and two (2) 25-gram containers of 2,2'-Azobis (cyclohexanecarbonitrile).

Advanced Chemical Transport, LLC (ACT), DBA ACTenviro has been contracted to conduct the treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of solutions to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that these chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from June 24, 2024 through August 30, 2024. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
