EMERGENCY PERMIT CENTURY HIGH SCHOOL

1401 S. Grand Avenue

Santa Ana, California 92705

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Century High School (CHS) for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 1401 S. Grand Ave. Santa Ana, California, 92705. The items treated include one 100gram container of Potassium.

The Clean Harbors Environmental Services has been contracted to conduct the treatment. The chemical is potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in its present state. The treatment involves the addition of solutions to the containers to stabilize the chemical. Once the chemical is treated, it will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that this chemical pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from May 15, 2024, through July 15, 2024. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
