## EMERGENCY PERMIT MATERIA, INC 60 NORTH SAN GABRIEL BOULEVARD PASADENA, CALIFORNIA 91107

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has issued an Emergency Permit to Materia, Inc for onsite treatment of expired chemicals at 60 North San Gabriel Boulevard, Pasadena, California 91107. The items treated include one (1) 1-ounce container of ethyl vinyl ether; one (1) 1-liter container of tetramethylene monovinyl ether; one (1) 100-milliliter container of styrene; five (5) 1-liter containers of divinylbenzene; one (1) 1-liter container of methyl styrene; three (3) 100-gram and one (1) 220-gram containers of sodium amide; one (1) 25-gram container of 2,4 dinitrophenylhydrazine; one (1) 100-gram, one (1) 1-gram, and two (2) 25-gram containers of 2,2 azobisisobutyronitrile; one (1) 500-milliliter container of borane tetrahydrofuran; and three (3) 500-gram containers of benzoyl peroxide.

The Clean Harbors Environmental Services (Clean Harbors) has been contracted to conduct the treatment. The chemicals are potentially reactive and unsafe for transport in their present state. The treatment involves the addition of solutions to the containers to stabilize the chemicals. Once the chemicals are treated, they will be transported offsite for proper management. DTSC has determined that these chemicals pose an imminent and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment if not properly managed. Therefore, an Emergency Permit should be issued. This Emergency Permit is effective from July 23, 2024 through September 20, 2024. The Emergency Permit includes measures to minimize any adverse impact to the community and the environment.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA):** DTSC has determined that the issuance of this permit is exempt from the requirements of CEQA and has filed a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the State Clearinghouse.
