

Work happening in your area

Environmental investigations will be completed for indoor air

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is overseeing the testing of indoor air and implementation of mitigation measures at the Former Fleet Aerospace Facility located at 310-312 Euclid Avenue in San Diego (Site). The work is being completed to address the volatile organic compounds (VOCs) contaminating soil and soil vapor (air between soil particles) at the Food 4 Less grocery store located at the Site. The VOCs are present due to a process known as vapor intrusion. Vapor intrusion occurs when chemical vapors in soil outside or beneath a building enter a building through cracks or other penetrations in the foundation, such as utility pipes or conduits.

Soil and soil vapor sampling recently completed in December 2024 found VOCs in soil samples collected from underneath the Food 4 Less grocery store's parking lot. DTSC is overseeing quarterly indoor air sampling, beginning January 2025, to confirm the latest mitigation measures at the Site are effectively reducing VOCs in indoor air.

What will happen?

Workers will place stainless steel canisters (see photo) within and around the Food 4 Less grocery store to collect samples of indoor air over an 8-hour period. The canisters will be sent to a laboratory and the indoor air samples trapped inside the canisters will be tested for VOCs. Based on the results, DTSC may require the collection of additional samples or installation of mitigation measures to improve indoor air quality.
