**AUTHORIZATION TO OPERATE A PERMANENT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION FACILITY (PHHWCF) PURSUANT TO A PERMIT BY RULE**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received Monterey Regional Waste Management District's (MRWMD) request to convert its grant of interim status for the PHHWCF located in Marina, California to a permit by rule. The MRWMD submitted a complete facility description and required attachments with its standardized permit application in 1994; thus no additional information is required to receive authorization under a permit by rule. The MRWMD's notification has been reviewed for completeness but has not been reviewed for technical adequacy. A technical review of the notification will be conducted when an inspection is performed. The MRWMD may be subject to penalty if violations of either laws or regulations are found.

The DTSC hereby rescinds the MRWMD's grant of interim status, and authorizes the MRWMD to operate the PHHWCF identified above under a permit by rule, pursuant to Title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 67270.60(d)(6).

The MRWMD must renotify the DTSC whenever any of the information provided in the initial notification changes significantly. To renotify, mail a cover letter to the above address explaining the change(s), along with a copy of the revised Form 1094B. The revised Form 1094B should have an asterisk in the left margin next to the revised information; it should also be re-signed and re-dated at the signature space on page 5.


As set forth in Title 22, CCR, Section 67450.25(a), this authorization is contingent upon the accuracy of the information submitted in the notification mentioned above. Any misrepresentation or any failure to fully disclose all relevant facts shall render this authorization to operate null and void.

Pursuant to Health & Safety Code Section 25205.3, household hazardous waste collection facilities operated by local government agencies are exempt from all state fees imposed by Article 9.1 of Health & Safety Code. As such, the MRWMD will not be charged any fees for the operation of this PHHWCF.
